PRACTICAL FIRE EXTINGUISHER COURSE

Contents: The practical fire extinguisher course can be run as a stand-alone course or as part of a half-day fire safety course suitable for fire wardens/marshals.

It covers the following areas:

Short classroom session (40 minutes)

- How fire develops and spreads
- Assessment on size of fire which staff can handle with equipment provided
- Fire phenomenon such as backdraughts
- Recap of local evacuation procedures

Practical fire extinguishing (up to 1 hour)

- Practical fire-fighting safety rules
- Using the PASS formula for safe use of extinguishers
- Practical use of range of extinguisher types on our propane fire simulator – all course attendees will use at least one extinguisher

The course comes with course notes and certification on successful completion of the course.

Venue/Site Requirements:

- Suitable venue for classroom session – tables, chairs etc
- 19kg propane cylinder with internal thread connector (customer supplied for our fire simulator)
- Area equivalent to five car park spaces.
- Not near combustible/flammable sources, air intakes etc.
- Hard standing, ideally not visible from a roadway.
- On your land, not easily accessible by the public.
- Passes our on-site risk assessment.
